Required Documents

- Invitation letter from the relative in Thailand
- Proof of relationship (birth / marriage certificate)
- Host passport and stay permit / ID copies
- Valid passport of applicant
- Two recent photographs (3.5 x 4.5 cm, white background)

Other Documents

- Proof of host's address and residential contract in Thailand
- Host's bank statements for last 3 months

Optional Documents

- Sponsorship declaration form

Application Process

1. We match your passport and port of entry to the correct online form or embassy appointment.
2. Funds, hotel bookings, and return/onward tickets are checked against Thai immigration expectations.
3. You submit payment for official fees only after we agree the file is coherent.
4. If an e-visa is issued, we help you understand validity dates before you book non-refundable flights.

5. Final entry is always decided by Thai immigration officers at the border.
